

The Bluebell Railway will be holding its annual sponsored walk – the Track Trek – to raise funds for its Tr(ack) Action Appeal.

This year the Trek offers a mid-Summers evening walk along the southern half of the line between Horsted Keynes Sheffield Park stations, a distance of 5 miles, on Saturday 30th June. It will allow walkers a first hand opportunity to see the track renewal works undertaken in recent months by the Railway’s Infrastructure Team at Holywell Waterworks and Rock Cutting.

Walking on a railway track is rough ground and stout footwear will be required and warm and waterproof clothing is essential. Dogs must be kept on a lead. Children under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult. The Trek is not considered suitable for children under 10.

The Trek will start from Horsted Keynes between 6:00 – 6:20pm with registration and safety briefings taking place from 5:00pm. Free parking will be available at Sheffield Park in order to catch a complimentary train to Horsted Keynes departing at 5:15pm. Alternatively for trekkers coming from the East Grinstead direction you can catch a complimentary train departing from East Grinstead at 5:00pm. After the Track Trek has finished a complimentary train service will depart from Sheffield Park at 9:00pm calling at Horsted Keynes at 9:15pm and East Grinstead at 9:40pm.

At registration trekkers will be expected to show sponsorship to the value of at least £20 per person or £35 for each family group (maximum two adults and three children). All trekkers will receive a certificate after completing the Trek. Trekkers who raise over £100 in sponsorship will receive a commemorative medal.
